REGISTRATION OF CAMPSITE AND DAY PASS - REQUIRED

Ride Camp is located within Iron Mountain Horse Camp at 4449 Arrowhead Drive, Ivanhoe, VA 24350. Camping reservation is required for this event. All trailer camping is equipped with water, electric hook up and barn is adjacent. Stalls are required per equine for stabling. Equines are not permitted in the campsites. By selecting your campsite and stall, you can join with friends or keep to yourself if you choose. Day Passes need to be paid by Leisure division riders in advance or prior to departure on the date of their ride at the IMHC office.

Ride Camp has requested that you are able to specify accurate vehicle length, additional needs – such as handicaps or unable to traverse steep inclines, etc. The more information you are able to provide, the better. Please keep accurate to vehicle length.

RULES, MAPS AND DETAILS –

I would like to remind all riders that **HELMETS are required for ALL RIDERS** at this facility. If you do not have a helmet, you will not be permitted to start and no refund will be provided. This is for the safety of all riders to ensure the next ride is possible. We thank you for understanding and complying with this rule.

You will be riding the rocky trails of the mountains. Since the terrain can be pretty rough, it's important to give your horse some hoof protection and for that reason **hoof protection on all four feet is strongly encouraged** for this ride. You'll encounter everything from old creek beds to newly graveled roads along the way. We will only have a farrier on-call. Their contact information can be seen on the Iron Mountain Horse Camp Website.

Maps will be provided digitally via email to every entered participant in advance of the ride. Large format posters will be displayed at camp as a reference for additional participants. Please do your best to print and have those maps ahead of arriving in camp.

Ride with GPS will be utilized as a navigational aid during this ride. I encourage you to download the app “Ride with GPS” and despite it having a bike logo – it is the correct app. Browse through this app and same instructions as with the maps- an email with instructions and a link to download all maps will be provided to entered participants. This service allows step by step alerts while offline to the traveler to keep them on trail. It will notify them of elevation, nearby roads, cell service availability, and water access. This is not required, but it would be a great aid for anyone new to the area as vandalism of trail markings do occur in this system. Ride with GPS is a free app to download and no additional cost is required to the participant to use this service. After learning how to use this, I have truly enjoyed it on my rides. Practice Now!

MEALS & ADDITIONAL NEEDS –Any additional needs should be made known to management as soon as possible to allow for accommodations. This would include any meal restrictions or requirements due to allergens or otherwise. Health conditions are also something management would like to be made aware.

CAMP RULES – Camp Rules will be heavily enforced and these are the requirements set by our insurance coverage as well as Iron Mountain Horse Camp. Neglect to follow any of these rules may incur immediate fee and removal from future events at this location.

-No Smoking: not allowed in any campground building including barns, bathhouse, hay barn, and tack office.

-Trash should be placed in dumpster. Any trash left behind will incur \$25 fee to ride management.

-Stall Cleanliness – stalls are required to be stripped at the end of event. You may pay \$15 to have your stall cleaned for you. If you leave stall uncleaned and have not paid, you will have a \$25 dollar fee to ride management.

-**DOGS ON LEASH** – This will be enforced. Any dog seen unrestrained or without a leash (and responsible human attached) may be confiscated and placed in our Doggy-Jail. Bail is set at \$50.

-No Illegal Dumping – Dump Station is on site and can be clarified by Iron Mountain Horse Camp office. It is illegal to dump gray and black water on road leaving camp without designated receptacle.

THE ROADS NEAR IMHC CAN BE NARROW AND TWISTY. PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY, ESPECIALLY WHEN APPROACHING OTHER VEHICLES. BE AWARE THAT YOUR LONG TRAILER MAY BE IN THE OTHER LANE IF YOU ARE ON A CURVE!!! Please DO NOT USE GPS OR MAP QUEST DIRECTIONS.

From I-77 from the South-

Take Exit 24 (Poplar Camp Road) and go West on 69 towards Austinville (4 miles)(*** Just before Austinville there is a short but very steep grade, if you are driving a really big trailer you may want to use the alternate route***). At stop sign in Austinville take a Left onto Austinville Road (69) to stop sign at 94 (4.0 miles). You are then at the Intersection of Hwy 94.

*****Alternate Directions for long trailers- Take Exit 24 and go right at the stop sign on 69. At stop sign take a Left onto hwy52 N. Go 4.0 miles and take Left onto 619 heading West. Go 2.5 miles to Austinville and continue forward to stop sign at Highway 94.

Once at Hwy 94 – Take a Left and follow 94 Continue 13.9 miles on Hwy-94 south. Turn right onto Brush Creek Rd. (602) Continue on Brush Creek Rd. for 5.5 miles and turn left onto Arrowhead Dr., which is a gravel road. The entrance to the campground will be the first right on Arrowhead Dr.

From I-81 N or S or I-77 from the North-

Take exit 80 off I-81 (Fort Chiswell/ Max Meadows). LAST FUEL. Take 52 South 1.2 miles, Turn Right at light onto 94 South towards Ivanhoe. Continue 13.9 miles on Hwy-94 south. Turn right onto Brush Creek Rd. (602) Continue on Brush Creek Rd. for 5.5 miles and turn left onto Arrowhead Dr., which is a gravel road. The entrance to the campground will be the first right on Arrowhead Dr.

ROAD CLOSURE-

Bridge on Brush Creek Road just before Hungry Horse East is going to be CLOSED from JUNE 1 to JUNE 31.

This means that if you leave Sunday, it's okay. If you leave Monday or later, you'll have to turn LEFT out of Arrowhead Road and follow Cripple Creek Road (602) > RIGHT on Gleaves Road > RIGHT on Huddle Road(619) *Curvy Roads, Go slow* and you're at HWY 94. If you cross 94, you're heading towards I-77.
